# Our Purpose:

- To help young adults become mature, responsible citizens.
- To acquire an understanding of adult occupational roles.
- To offer the opportunity to examine the Law Enforcement profession as a possible career.
- 4. To develop a permanent set of values.
- 5. To accept a more responsible social role.
- To create a better understanding of social relations programs at the Local, State and Federal levels.
- To create a better community and police relationship.
- To create a better understanding of social relationships between youth and adults of the community.
- To help create a better understanding between the Police Department and the youth of the community.

# **Post Meetings:**

Each Post holds regular meetings 2 to 3 times a moeth. There are nine (9) Explorer Post serving the Baltimore Police Department. The Post locations are in the back of this brochure.

#### Requirements For Membership:

- Open to all residents who meet the following requirements and qualifications without regard to race, creed, sex, ethnicity or disability.
- 2. The membership shall be composed of young adults both male and female, at least fourteen (14) years of age and has completed the eight grade or has not yet reached their 21st birthday. An Explorer registered in a post prior to their twenty-first (21) birthday may continue as a member until the Post recharters or until they reach their 22nd birthday, which ever comes first.
- Members must be responsible citizens with a good reputation and maintain a good moral character.
- 4. Explorer member's grades must be in good standing with an overall passing grade average of "C" or better. Failure to comply with this rule will result in a review by the Post Advisor. The Post Advisor may recommend suspension from the Post activities until such time the Explorer's academic performance meet standards.
- Members will be required to present their quarterly report cards to the Post Advisors.
- Explorer members shall observe all the by-laws and all of their rules for the government of the Post and the Post Committee.
