Truck Company #30 responds to approximately 1505 calls last year

Squad 54 responds to approximately 1821 calls last year

Medic Unit #13 responds to approximately 4874 calls last year

Fires are slightly down from last year

EMS responses are slightly down

Squad 54 was placed in service in 1922 as Engine Company #54 located 4008 White Avenue and moved to the current house in 1955. In 2002 changed their designation from Engine to Squad with the added responsibilities of HAZMAT, technical rescue, Vehicle rescue, swift water rescue and confined space rescue as part of the homeland security initiative.

Truck Company #30 was placed in service in 1955 in the current firehouse. The main job for Truck Company #30 is to search for and rescue victims, for which they have been award four unit citations for lives saved.

Medic 13 was originally housed on Pulaski Highway and relocated to Belair Road in 2002

Along with Fire, EMS, rescue, HAZMAT and service responses we are responsible for maintaining our house and apparatus, attend trainings including continuing educations to maintain certifications, conduct building inspections, fire drills, hydrant inspections/maintenance, install/inspect home smoke detectors, assist schools with fire prevention activities and are a staple of the communities. And of course like any other operation maintain offices and administrative work.
